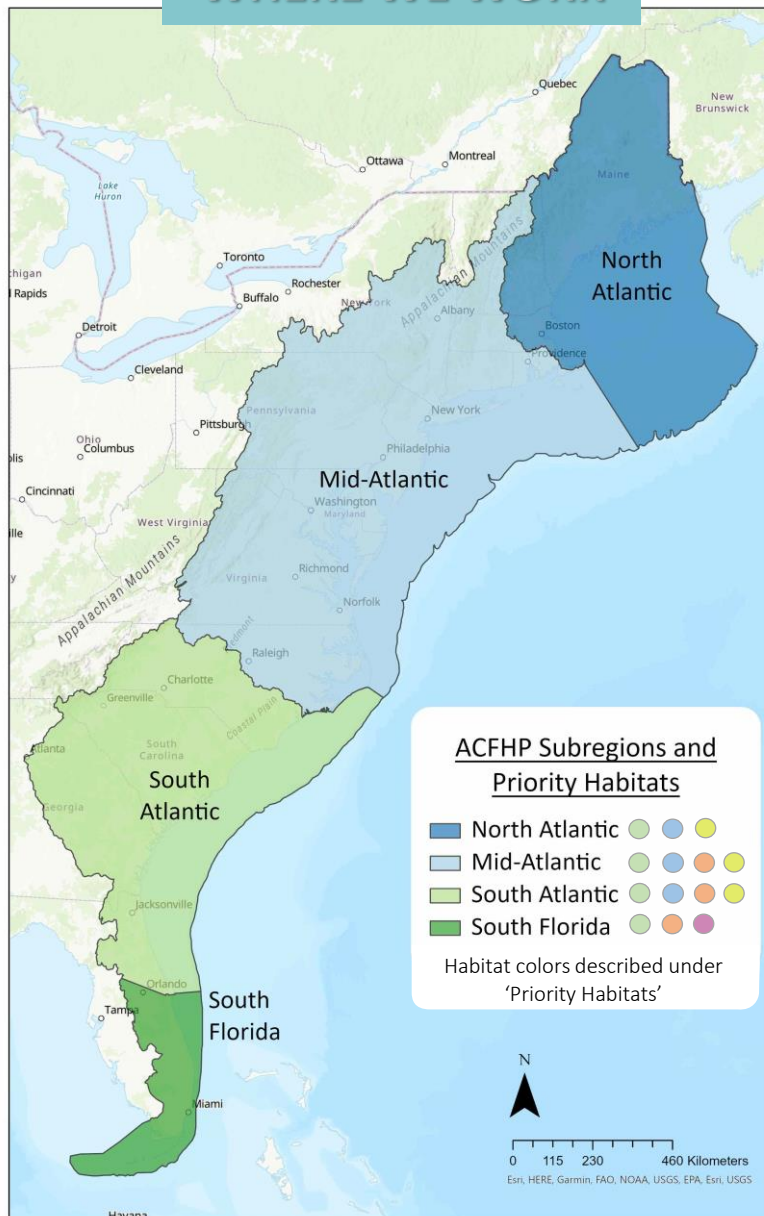

rivers, estuaries, and coasts.

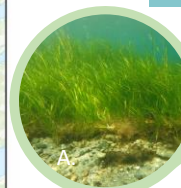

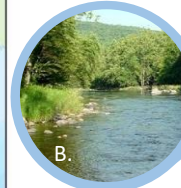

## PRIORITY HABITATS



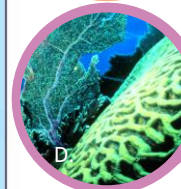
Submerged Aquatic
